Requirements for separate containers for residual waste

In the future, your company must have its own containers for residual waste, regardless of the amount of residual waste produced. Your company must not use residents' containers for residual waste.

You must decide whether your residual waste should be collected by Frederiksberg Municipality or by a private waste collector.

F Sign up at frederiksberg.dk/erhvervsaffald by clicking on the box 'Tilmeld dig den kommunale ordning for erhvervsaffald'.

P Find a list of authorised waste collectors on affaldsregister.ens.dk. Note that 'residual waste' is called 'forbrændingseget affald'.

Recyclable waste collection

As a minimum, companies are required by law to sort food waste, paper, cardboard, glass, metal, plastic, food & drink cartons, hazardous waste and textile waste.

If you have small amounts of recyclable waste

If your company produces recyclable waste that is similar in nature and quantity to the waste produced by a private household, you have three options:

F You can use Frederiksberg Municipality's scheme

- If your company is located in a property with private households, you can use the same containers as the residents.
- If your company is located in an independent property, you will be provided with your own containers.

G You can drop off your sorted waste at a recycling centre
Please note that the recycling centre does not accept food waste, frying oil or residual waste.

P You can set up a contract with a private waste collection company. You can find a list of authorised waste collectors on affaldsregister.ens.dk.

If you produce large quantities of recyclable waste

If the amount of recyclable waste exceeds what one household typically produces, the municipality is not allowed to collect it. In this case, you have two options:

P Set up an agreement with a private waste collector to collect your sorted waste. You can find a list of authorised waste collectors on affaldsregister.ens.dk

G Drop off your sorted waste at a recycling centre
Please note that the recycling centre does not accept food waste, frying oil or residual waste.
